We are now looking for a new Assistant County Commissioner (Explorer Scouts)

This is a fantastic opportunity to take on this exciting and varied role; you would be joining the County's Youth Programme team reporting to the Deputy County Commissioner (Programme), with responsibility for managing the Derbyshire Explorer's and growing a team to support Explorer Scouting in Derbyshire.

The main area of responsibilities for the role include, but are not limited to the following points:

- Building and maintaining productive and supportive relationships with the District Explorer Scout Commissioners & The network Commissioner
- Chair D.E.S.C meetings and expand their programme where appropriate.
- Maintain a working relationship with DCs, D.E.S.C and other Commissioners within the County.
- Supervise any County events for Explorer Scouts.
- Promote the Young Leader scheme.
- Promote linking opportunities with the refreshed network section
- Keep up to date with the general rules and programme for the Cub



section, including badges and awards.

- Working with the CC and County Team to promote Scouting in Derbyshire and at a local level within districts.

This role is ideal for someone with excellent communication and interpersonal skills, an up-to-date knowledge of the Explorer Scouting who understands the importance of providing Section Support in Scouting and can communicate well with young people and adults of all ages. You would be required to have the time to attend average of one meeting per week as well as time to plan and prepare meetings, communications and work on projects where applicable.

This is a great time to consider this role, the Explorer Scout section has seen a good level of growth within the last couple of years and a number of exciting projects are already in discussion. Support from the DCC Programme will be available as part of the induction for the role.
